HERE'S A PEEK BEHIND THE SCENES OF THE FESTIVAL, WHERE TRADITION AND AVANT-GARDE MIX TOGETHER!



Founded over 40 years ago, it has been called TICINO MUSICA since 1997. The master classes, which were the focus of this international meeting of young musicians in 1979, are still an important part of the whole today, but over the years it has evolved in different directions, adding the "Silvio Varviso" opera studio and the festival orchestra, with wide international appeal.

A major part of the work consists of concerts and related events such as opera, symphonic concerts, solorecitals, chamber music, seminars, exhibitions. Every year, more than 80 events are offered to the attentive, loyal public throughout Ticino during the two weeks, a variety that other music promoters may offer over the period of a year in their concert season.

In addition to the famous artists (international soloists, among them members of the best orchestras in the world) who present interesting solo or chamber music programs, ensembles in residence and winners of international competitions, the focus is on young soloists at the beginning of their international careers.

In the TICINO MUSICA Festival, the master class participants have the opportunity to play both individually, in small groups with other young musicians and in specific projects with their renowned professors. The audience can gain an insight into the processes and secrets of artistic work by participating as a listener in the master classes, rehearsals of the Opera Studio and the Orchestral Academy. This is a real summer concert season with great masters and promising young musicians, which includes two very intense and content-rich weeks throughout Ticino, mainly promoted by the TICINO MUSICA Circle of Friends.

In 2021, the TICINO MUSICA festival celebrated its 25th anniversary. Almost 10,000 young musicians from all over the world have been able to gain important experience for their professional lives; more than 1,000 internationally recognised personalities of classical music have passed on their art to the young musicians and have given concerts in various forms, and the participants are personally supervised by the organisers. TICINO MUSICA also financially supports young talented musicians, so that they can attend the master classes, the opera studio and the orchestra academy.

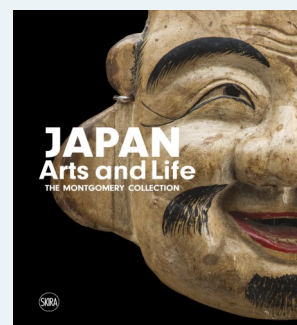
MUSEC – Lugano Museum of Culture

JAPAN. Arts and Life. The Montgomery Collection.

THURSDAY, 10 MARCH – 14.00

“This major exhibition is **one of the largest and best-known collections of Japanese art outside Japan**. Set up on two floors of the “Spazio Mostre” in Villa Malpensata, home of MUSEC, the exhibition ‘**JAPAN. ARTS AND LIFE**’ presents **one hundred and seventy works from the period between the 12th and 20th centuries** including textiles, furniture, paintings, religious and everyday-objects - carefully selected from the over one thousand objects collected over a lifetime by Jeffrey Montgomery. Renowned worldwide, the Montgomery Collection displays an extraordinary richness and a very singular substance: it is a collection of ‘oriental art’, and at the same time it expressed a “folk culture” reinterpreted in very elevated aesthetic terms by the elegant and refined choices made by the collector who had dedicated his entire life to it.”

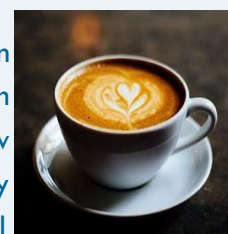
