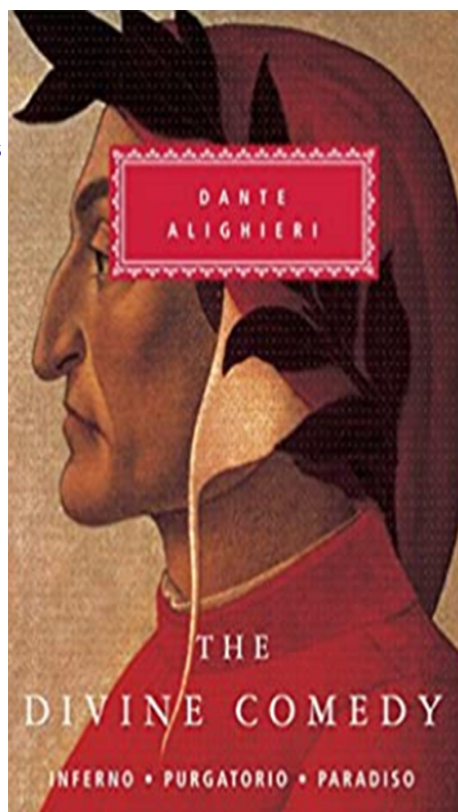

Andrea Pera was born in Perugia, Italy, and has dual Italian and Swiss citizenship. He lives in Lugano and has worked as a teacher of humanistic subjects (Italian, Philosophy, History) in various secondary schools and universities in Italy, Germany and Switzerland. His teaching method is based on the activation of motivation on the part of students, so that studying is a pleasure for the development of knowledge and skills without boring punishment. To this end, he has always used audio-visual means (films, pictures, etc.) in addition to the traditional teaching tools (books, etc.)

"The Divine Comedy begins in a shadowed forest on Good Friday in the year 1300. It proceeds on a journey that, in its intense recreation of the depths and the heights of human experience, has become the key with which Western civilization has sought to unlock the mystery of its own identity." (Allen Mandelbaum)

The brief presentation of the life and the main work of Dante (father of the Italian language), the Divine Comedy, will be based on the vision of images that will be explained and commented, in order to involve those who participate in the meeting, and transmit the human, religious and cultural values that the work of Dante still presents us.

IWCL VOUCHER INITIATIVE

Project Launch Date: Tuesday, 5 April

Our member Piera Serra has been working with the Board on an idea linked to our 'Cosmetics for Ukraine' project. The working title is "A Small Gesture of Welcome from our Hair and Beauty Professionals in Lugano."

With the backing of the Ticinese professional hair and beauty institutions, **Coiffure Suisse and Associazione Estetiste della Svizzera Italiana**, we will offer a voucher to refugees for another morale-boosting, self-caring, social, relational experience – a hair cut, restyle, colour; or perhaps a facial, manicure or pedicure.

We have created an explanatory flyer which you can find here in English and Italian. It needs to be distributed to hair and beauty salons across Lugano. This is where you, our wonderful members, come in. **We are asking you to take one flyer to your own salon, on behalf of IWCL, and explain the initiative** – that they offer one free treatment to an Ukrainian refugee.

We hope that individual salon owners will then feel able to issue a voucher for a treatment, by calling Piera to register for the scheme, or by sending the voucher to Sue.

The vouchers for individual salons will then be made available to refugees in Lugano via various support networks, and through contacts with host families, organised by the Board. We have created a press-release for maximum publicity of this IWCL initiative; the full launch took place on 5 April at the Monthly Meeting.

We are delighted to be able to offer you a guided tour of The Swiss National Sound Archives.

The Swiss National Sound of Archives with its headquarters in Lugano is the sound archive of Switzerland and is responsible for safeguarding the sound heritage of our country. It was created in 1987 as a foundation under private law. In January 2016 the foundation was dissolved and the Phonotheque was integrated with the Federal Office of Culture as the "Swiss National Sound Archives Section" of the Swiss National Library. The Swiss National Sound Archives collects and catalogues audio documents, both in music and in spoken word, that have a relationship with Swiss history and culture, example: recordings of classical, rock, jazz, and folk music, audio books, tales, theatre plays, interviews, research documents (field recordings) or private collections.



The visit is free of charge; however we have a limit of 20 guests, therefore our cancellation policy will apply (CP). No shows will be charged CHF 10, which will be donated to our charity
